
3 Styles Suitable in either SD (4:3/TV) or HD (16:9/Widescreen) and 2 Styles in Sd and HD

These styles are meant as transitions between two images, either portrait or landscape. Portrait images are sized to fill the screen and so may be use instead of a landscape image. With a portrait image though, often the area of interest is usually not in the middle of the image so you may need to adjust it up or down as appropriate.

Radial Zoom Fade Out**Requires 2 Landscape Images**

Any Aspect

Setup: Layer 1 will show after layer 2

Layer 1 transitions into view by clockwise rotating spokes which will spreadout from the screen center.

Round Cross-Fade**Requires 2 Landscape Images**

Any Aspect

Setup: Layer 1 will show after layer 2

Layer 1 transitions into view when two circles fade into view and grow to fill the screen.

Triangle Cross- Fade**Requires 2 Landscape Images**

Any Aspect

Setup: Layer 1 will show after layer 2

Triangles grow from the sides into the screen center to reveal the next image

Triangle Fade 1**Requires 2 Landscape Images**

SD and HD

Setup: Layer 1 will show after layer 2

The image in layer 1 is revealed as a triangular section grows from the screen center.

Triangle Fade 2**Requires 2 Landscape Images**

SD and HD

Setup: Layer 1 will show after layer 2

The same as Triangle Fade 1 except that all visible portions of layer 2 are growing and rotating as the triangle appears. Also, layer 2 comes into view in a kaleidoscopic fashion.
